

Naturland's Organic worldwide programme

Naturland has been accredited by IFOAM (International Federation of Organic Agriculture Movements) since 1997.

To achieve IFOAM accreditation, Naturland is inspected regularly by IOAS (International Organic Accreditation Services) which is a respected independent organisation. As an independent body, IOAS is appointed by IFOAM to implement the IFOAM accreditation programme. Transparency and openness are the basis of this system. Naturland discloses its certification work during annual evaluation tours and allows IOAS to inspect its records.

Producers, processors and consumers perceive recognition by IFOAM as internationally renowned proof of Naturland's quality assurance system, testifying to the reliability of Naturland's certification of organic agricultural produce, from the source to the finished product.

Recognition of Naturland as a certification organisation with international accreditation facilitates the international exchange of organically produced goods.

With its Organic worldwide certification programme, Naturland provides its members with an opportunity to conform with the requirements of IFOAM's basic standards. The difference between Naturland's standards and Naturland's Organic worldwide standards is to be found in the area of processing, in the certification of permissible raw goods and in the processing agents allowed for certain groups of products.

Naturland members certified under the Naturland Organic worldwide programme are allowed to use the Naturland organic worldwide logo.
